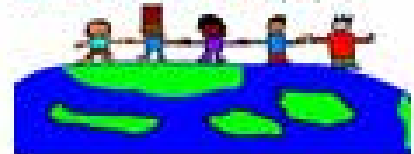

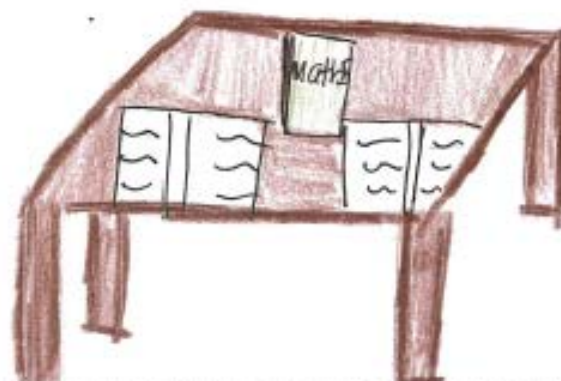

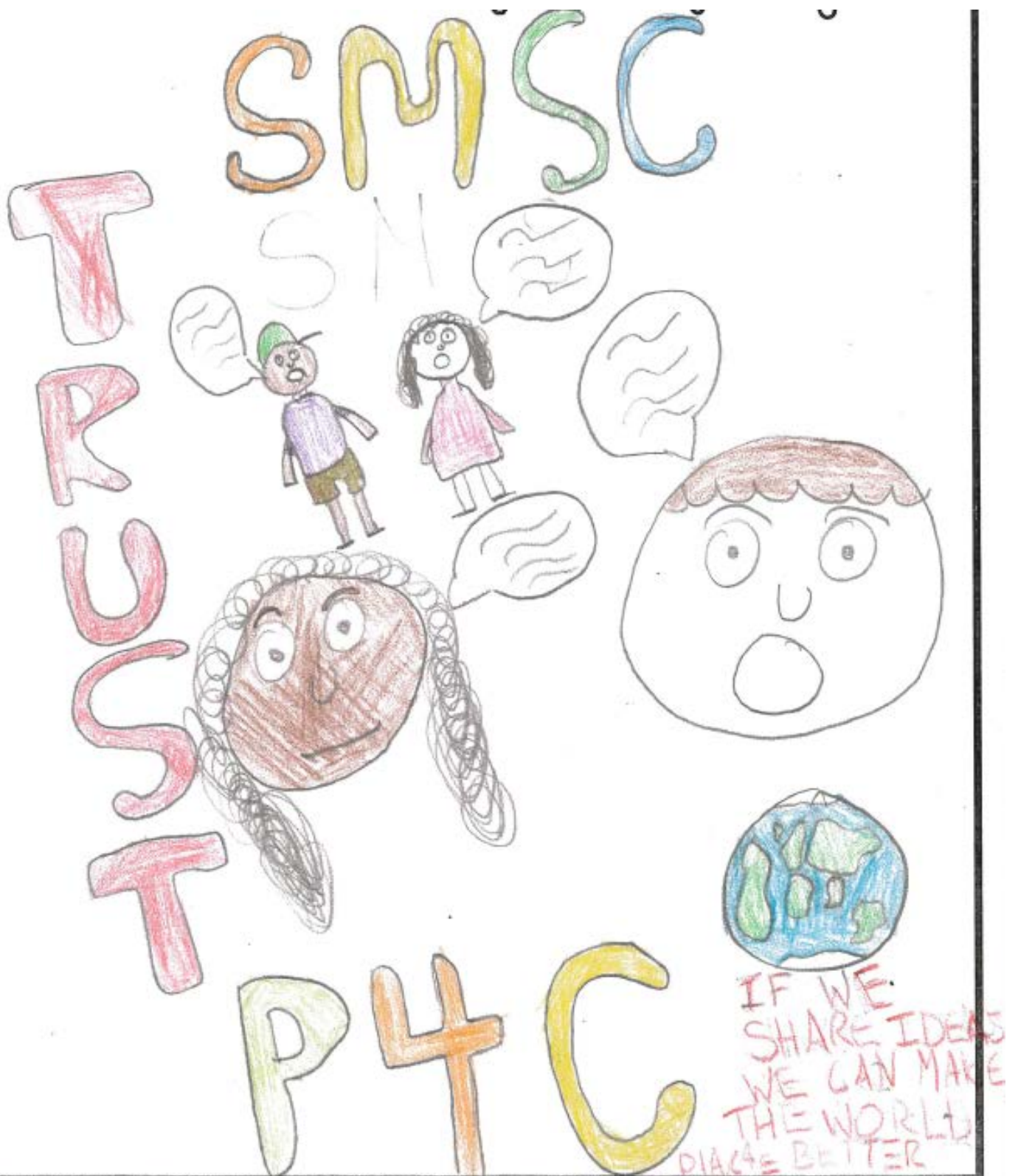

You have the responsibility to always display good manners by showing respect to the people around you.

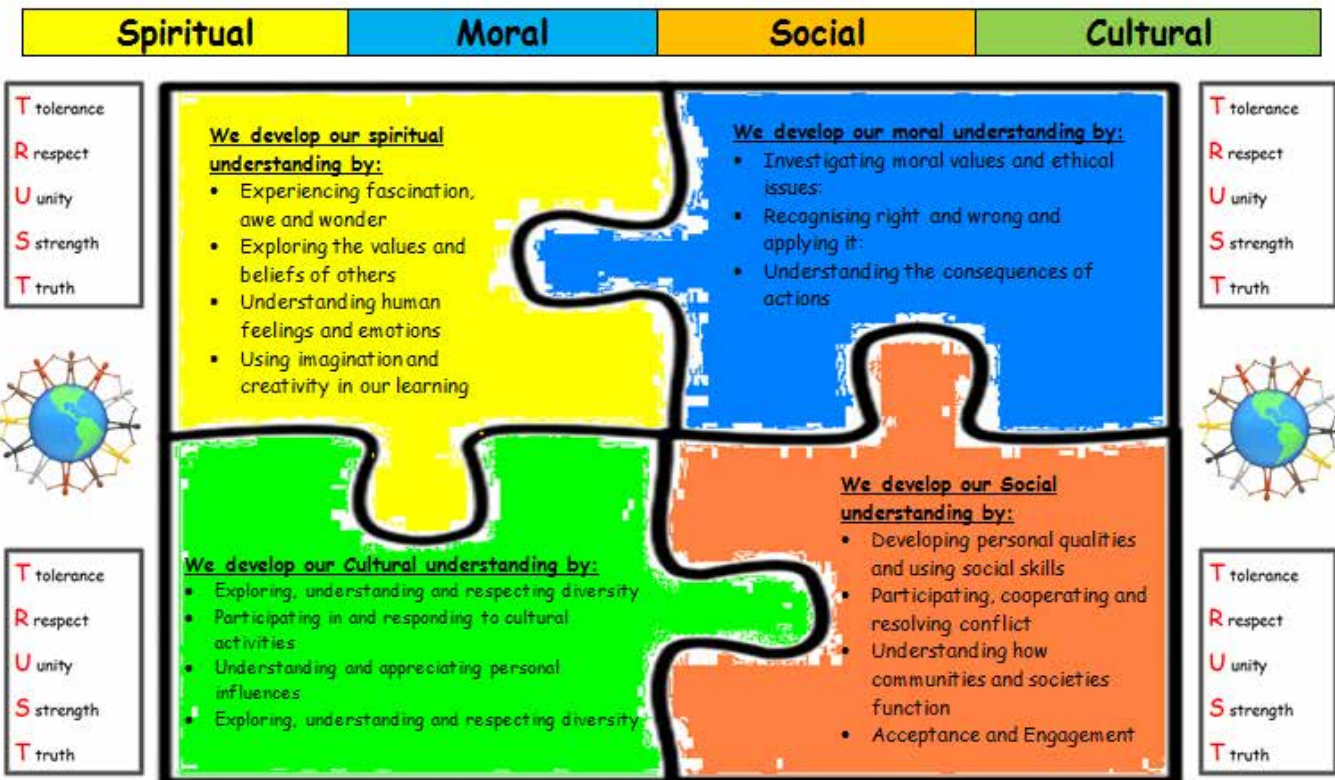
