



Sports Premium Funding 2020-2021



Clearly being closed due to Covid for 4 terms within the financial year above, means we have a great underspend in this area. However on the children's return in September 2020 and March 2021, additional PE sessions were planned and delivered to ensure the children increased their fitness levels and re-engaged their enjoyment of PE. The additional funding now carried over into this year's budget has paid for our new Fitness/Sensory Circuit in the junior playground, 5 a day fitness activities, termly Bounce (trampoline) workshops (as requested by the children), George Fouche (fitness and well being coach) who visited Cobham, as well as 2 GB athletes who visited Cobham during an amazing Sports and Health Week in July 2021. They were an inspiration to us all!

The **impact** of greater levels of sporting opportunities can be seen in the data below collected during the school year 20-21 using our Golden Mile assessments. Average distance achieved

by the children in every class improved term on term and one can see the impact of the summer holiday on the children looking at the data analysed in the first term of 21-22, who once again seemed to have regressed in their fitness levels due to a lack of PE lessons and physical activity during the summer!



Attendance last year continued to be high! At the end of the school year, 98.2% was our attendance figure with 70 pupils achieving 100% attendance throughout the year!

In Years 1 through to 6 - only 3 children did not meet expected levels in PE! 98% of the whole school were expected + in PE.

84% of our SEN achieved expected + in PE with 8% of our SEN exceeding

In Years 1 to 6 – only 1 Pupil Premium Child did not meet expected levels meaning that 83% did achieve expected + in PE.

During a monitoring pupil voice capture children commented ‘we loved the whole school wake up and shake up sessions during Sports Week because it was the first time the whole school was allowed to be together.’
