### 9. BUILDINGS & GROUNDS

Fire alarm is old and defunct - bit like the head- needs replacing! Bit like the headteacher! Report and actions to be discussed and actioned by Governors, Head and Office Manager.

### 10. Governors

Governors have undertaken learning walks in SEN, PSHE, Maths & English. Governors have also visited and attended school council meetings, parent sessions on PSHE and Well being. Governors have also undertaken training in Ofsted and Governance.

### 11. Sports Premium

Over £17,000 continues to ensure that PE, Sport & Health have a high priority at Cobham. This funding allows us to ensure that Premier Sports continue to be part of the PE curriculum. We have had additional support from them for our Play leader Training in Term 5 and 6 with Year 5. It also supported the costs and planning for Sports week this term with 2 GB athletes- Aidan Syers and Louise Evans visiting Cobham, Wise Up Workshops for the Whole School as well as new resources for Sports Day!

### 12. Pupil Premium

Sensory Circuit sessions continue for some of our children at the start of each day with their class TA. Jasmine (SLT) made a visit early in Term 5 and again in Term 6- children and teams were provided with plans and exercises to support them in this area. She was also commissioned to undertake an assessment and provide a report for the purposes of seeking a diagnosis for a child. 4 of the PP children are attending after school clubs for free this term. They are always offered first choice. Residential trips for PP children were covered by this funding too. School trips for our PP children have been paid for. T shirts for the KS2 production have also been purchased for our PP children.

## 13. Safeguarding -

Since April 2022 we have completed 8 pre-concern forms (2 for 1 child), 9 green safeguarding forms and have received 1 Operation Encompass.

8 of the 9 green forms led to meetings with parents. 4 of the pre safeguarding forms also led to conversations with parents.

The OE notification did not lead to EH support as offence had taken place over phone and children were unaware of situation.

3 of the children are receiving Time2 Talk counselling this term.

In summary 29 Green Forms have been completed this year. 5 were noted and no actions taken. 24 families were contacted via email or telephone. 3 OE encompass triggers. We have offered one family support from EH and Front Door, but they did not wish to pursue this.
