## **9. BUILDINGS & GROUNDS**

Connect to the Classroom Grant is now complete with handover to Mr Burns. All tree work was completed over October half term by Countrywide. The Fire Alarm replacement is still ongoing as we are awaiting to hear from KCC/Skanska on what company will be installing. I have received 4 quotations for the telecoms to be upgraded and have a site visit from a local company soon to discuss our options. A Fire Risk Review was carried out 20<sup>th</sup> October 2022 with no new recommendations. Legionella Risk Assessment works were carried out over October half term by CPS Management Services Ltd. They have been back recently to quote for a new cold water storage tank or POU heaters in infant toilets and Years 1, 2 and 3 as the classrooms do not have a hot water supply. An electric heater has been replaced, outside lights and a socket has been renewed. Drains and gullies in the infant playground and behind the school hall have had their yearly clean. All health & safety tests are carried out each term.

## **10. Governors**

Governors have undertaken learning walks in English, Maths, SEN, EYFS and have led both formal and informal monitoring visits including Well-being, SEN Roadshow, Remembrance Day, School Council and Safeguarding.

### 11. Sports Premium

Over £17,000 continues to ensure that PE, Sport & Health have a high priority at Cobham. This funding allows us to ensure that Premier Sports continue to be part of the PE curriculum. The last two terms each class has experienced 5 weeks of PE lessons with Premier Sports each term. This allocation has also funded Bounce, Glow in the Dark Dodgeball and Roots to Food.

### 12. Pupil Premium

Sensory Circuit sessions continue for some of our children at the start of each day with their class TA. Jasmine (SLT) made a visit early in Term 1 and again in Term 2- children and teams were provided with plans and interventions to support them in this area. She was also commissioned to undertake an assessment and provide a report for the purposes of seeking a diagnosis for a child. 8 of the PP children are attending after school clubs for free this term. They are always offered first choice. School trips for our PP children in Year 6 have been paid for. RE Workshops that were partly paid for by donations from parents, also supported all our PP children with these costs.
